INTRODUCTION

The Lord released a word to me in the early hours of 2nd October 2021 that had me rejoicing. I heard the words, “My unexpected is NOW”. They were followed shortly by a melody and the words of the song which are as follows:

I'm open, expecting.

I was already in a position of jubilee as I had just heard a testimony that blew my mind. A sister shared that her colleague had received ten times his salary in his bank account and she coincidentally had received five times the amount she normally receives in her account. When the employer was questioned about the money, they revealed that it was a legitimate payment. An audit had been conducted and it was revealed that the colleague had received a promotion five years ago and was never given financial compensation. He was “now” being compensated for that error. Well, I started rejoicing as if the money had been deposited in my bank account!

Later that day, I received a prophetic word from a respected Apostle who walks in the prophetic and said the Lord had told her that “Janita is a NOW woman.” There was more that was shared but I was like WOW, a NOW woman.

The next morning, a friend “randomly” shared with me a CNN tweet that stated that a multimillion-dollar stretch of prime Southern California beachfront real estate could now be returned to the descendants of its rightful black owners, nearly a century after the parcel was taken by the City of Manhattan Beach. The unlawful confiscation occurred during the Jim Crow era. Well, I started one bit of jumping- “God is this what you are about to do for your people with this word in song?” I asked.

As if that wasn’t enough, on that same Sunday, 3rd October 2021, my Bishop (who I hadn’t shared the song or testimonies with) was preaching in this same vein. She was not even supposed to be the preacher that day but the spirit of the Lord was so heavy on her that she had to release what He was saying. She said that God was expediting His word for us in this season. She was so impassioned about what the Lord was doing for us. We were encouraged not to relinquish our faith as the Lord WILL do it. She encouraged us to go back to our situations (i.e. go back to your “no” as there is a “yes” there).

It was crazy- literally three independent confirmations of His word to me in less than 48 hours!!!

In a matter of days, I would begin to see God moving in unexpected ways. I want to share some of those testimonies with you, take you through the scriptures and the revelation of them that God shared, and finally provide some of the things we

should employ to position ourselves to possess ALL that God has for us in this season. If YOU are ready for your unexpected, follow me!

Testimonies (Early Manifestations of the Word)

It is important that we are able to recognize the unexpected when it manifests. I'm only sharing four of the many stories of unexpected blessings that I and others connected to me received immediately following the release of God's word to me.



AN UNEXPECTED TRIP

On 8th October 2021 (six days after I received the word), I received a save-the-date notification from a client for a celebratory event that was stated to be held overseas. I made a mental note of it expecting that they would have the few of us in Bermuda attend the event virtually. On 11th October 2021, I received an email following up on the notification. The writer apologized for the short notice but asked me to confirm whether I would be attending as the event was to be held on 11th November 2021 and arrangements for the private plane and hotel had to be arranged by the company. Well, I started to do my happy dance. Wow, I hadn't traveled for over two years and my first trip off of the island would be on a private plane, this was certainly my unexpected. Ten or so minutes later, reality set in as I thought about making arrangements for my 8-year-old and the resultant effects that travel would have on her once I returned to the island, for example, her in-person school attendance or my husband attending his job. I concluded that while an awesome opportunity, I couldn't attend. I politely thanked the client for the invite and declined.

They responded by asking if I was sure that I couldn't make it happen as they really wanted me (and all invitees) to attend and would do all that they could facilitate that. As such, I revisited the request, checked in with family members and friends to see if they could support me with my daughter while I was overseas, and a few days later I was able to say a qualified "yes". Due to a change of policy, I was unable to travel on the date that the private plane was scheduled but I later saw that it was a divine setup from the Lord. I traveled safely (by commercial carrier) to the destination four days earlier than other invitees. I had the time to get the rest I needed and the time and inspiration to prepare a poem and song that I would perform at the event. I was able to honor the visionaries of the client company whom I had the privilege of working with and who I greatly respected and admired. I was also able to perform in song (yes you read correctly) with the band Rhythm Collective (a highly rated US-based band and part of the Elan Artists Group) at the event!! Euphoric doesn't adequately define it. The performance, which was captured on video, has become one of the 10 "pick me up memories," that brain

expert Staci Danford says you should have at your fingertips to view to immediately bring you joy. There were so many unexpected blessings on that trip and not just for me, the Lord allowed those connected to me to receive unexpected blessings. My girlfriend Maria who was my guest at the event did get to experience the private jet and we had the girl trip that we had talked about for ages. My friend Melanie was able to get her embroidery machine back from the US, which she previously wasn't able to ship due to cost. How I got to know about the machine and have it transported on the private plane is simply a miracle.



UNEXPECTED INTERVENTION

The second unexpected and immediate blessing was experienced by a gentleman that I will call Mr. G. By way of brief background, on the 14th of January 2020, the Lord instructed me to go to the park during my lunch hour and I would find the person who I was sent for. After greeting many people in the park, I stood before two gentlemen, one of whom said, “You’re so beautiful, you must be a lawyer”. It was a strange statement to make, but being a corporate lawyer and not known to either gentleman, (both senior citizens) I took it as a sign. I was in a time of fasting and prayer and had purposed to bless someone with a meal each of the 21 days that I was fasting. They were that day’s recipients. I explained that I wanted to bless them with a meal and asked if there was anything that I could pray for. Mr. G responded that he needed somewhere to live as he was living in an abandoned car and it was cold. Having received what I believed to be my assignment, I took it to the Lord in prayer and reached out to my network on his behalf. Fast forward to March 11th, 2020, ten days before Bermuda went into its first COVID -19 lockdown, that gentleman, Mr. G, was nestled comfortably into his new apartment. Hallelujah! But that wasn’t the best part: on the 10th of March 2020, I was able to lead him to the Lord. Look at the Lord, He used me to get His lost sheep and to bring him home.

I have remained involved in Mr. D’s life and on 25th November 2021, the Holy Spirit prompted me to make an appointment with his doctor as I required her consent on a form for an application, I desired to make on Mr. D’s behalf. On 30th November 2021, after being seen and having his vitals taken, the doctor sent us straight away to the emergency department of our local hospital. Mr. G’s blood pressure was 234/160 sitting down. He could have suffered a stroke on the spot. After a 3-hour hospital stay, the situation was averted! Thank you, Jesus!

On 12th January 2022, my sister-friend Mrs. H, who by God’s grace partnered with me to look out for Mr. G, took him to the grocery store. She saw that he was breathless just after getting into the car and she didn’t like what she saw. So back to the doctor and once seen, back to the hospital. This time, he was on the verge of having a heart attack, why because they discovered blood clots on his lungs. Mr.

G sat with tears streaming, recognizing for the second time how God had spared his life through the intervention of his “two angels”. Ten days later on his birthday, 22nd January 2022, he was released from the hospital, breathing better and with a greater appreciation for life, a desire to pursue his purpose, and being altogether grateful. What unexpected blessings!



UNEXPECTED SUPPORT

On December 1st, 2021, the Lord assigned me to an elderly lady, who I'll refer to as Mrs. D. who needed help getting her legal affairs in order. I thought that my assignment was to simply help her complete the required paperwork in preparation for her meeting with an estate lawyer. I discovered very quickly that Father God had other plans and this is the third unexpected testimony that I will share.

Mrs. D. was lonely and emotionally quite fragile as her husband had recently been taken to hospital and there was no one daily looking out for her. Mr. A. who represented the agent for her landlord had over the years frequently checked in on Mrs. D. and her husband, however, he had to travel urgently for a week. Mrs. D. was so grateful for my company after the first meeting. I agreed to treat her to lunch for our second meeting to finish off the paperwork the following week. I realized during that week that she really needed care and so daily I began checking in on her, ensuring that she had taken her medication, that she had meals, took her to visit her husband, and took her on outings. During this time, Mr. A's trip was extended due to unforeseen circumstances and when he returned, he had to quarantine for fourteen days. Mrs. D's husband was readying for release from the hospital and I knew that I was not equipped to care for two. Notwithstanding, I was advised that Mr. D was coming home and desired to be home before Christmas, I had three days to get help in place.

Having been provided with a short list of service providers, I reached out to three of them, arranged interviews with Mrs. D. and myself, and in three days engaged a caregiver, collected Mr. D from the hospital, and reunited this couple. God did the unexpected as only He could!

On 4th January 2022, having made doctor's appointments for them both, I arrived to take Mr. and Mrs. D. to their appointments. Mrs. D's eyes were almost swollen shut and hadn't been like that the day before. We went to the Dr and she sent us straight to the emergency department at the hospital to ensure that whatever was causing the reaction wasn't affecting Mrs. D's breathing. This was not how any of

us planned to spend the day. The allergic reaction seemed to also affect Mrs. D's internal plumbing which resulted in her having to go to the bathroom every 15 minutes. We laughed over the 7 hours that we were at the hospital about how our friendship had changed as I had seen and wiped her bottom not only for number 1 (urine) but also for number 2 (bowel movement). Being childless herself and not having many friends as a couple, they couldn't believe how God had brought them (at this stage in their lives) a friend that loved and cared for them.

On the 23rd of January 2022, Mr. D. had a fall at home which required a visit via ambulance to the hospital. Mr. and Mrs. D were both so frightened and expressed that they had forgotten how to do everything in the face of the crisis. Mrs. D said, "I didn't even know how to use the phone. I had to be told step by step how to get the ice from the freezer." Mr. D. said he was completely out of it too. One of the caregivers walked Mrs. D. through the process of checking on Mr. D., getting him ice for his head and then being able to call emergency to get him assessed. I picked up Mr. D. upon his discharge a few hours later and he exclaimed how glad he was to see me. It was heartwarming to watch the couple embrace and give thanks to God that Mr. D. was okay. Mrs. D. asked me if she could give me the tightest hug she's ever given. What an unexpected and needed blessing my support has been to the couple. But better still, what a tremendous blessing I have received. What joy I received taking Mrs. D. to the restroom a million times, to the commode in her hospital room, cleaning her bumpy to ensure that she maintained her dignity. Just like our God to cover us in such a magnificent way and to honor His word: "our latter will be better than our past".

I will shift shortly to the revelation that the Holy Spirit shared with me about the song. However, as I recount what the Father has done for me, others connected to me, and to those whom I released the word to in the days, weeks, and less than four months since receiving it, is nothing short of amazing and He must be glorified.



UNEXPECTED FAVOUR

The fourth and final unexpected testimony that I will share, but not the last of the unexpected manifestations that I or others experienced, is the story of my good friend in the UK, who I'll refer to as Mrs. B. Three days after I received the word, she shared with me that she was contemplating moving offices and wanted my opinion on such a move. Mrs. B. gave her reasons and said she had prayed about it and was sensing it was time to move. While I hadn't prayed about the move myself, I felt that the word I had received was applicable and that indeed it was time for her to step out in faith.

She decided to proceed, located office space closer to her home and daughter's school, and put in an offer for the space. In very short order, she closed on the agreement, circulated her moving notices, and officially took possession of the space in mid-November 2021. This new space was twice the size of her old space, located on the main road in the town, came with a designated parking space (she previously paid GBP100 a month for parking at the previous premises), and was a 20 minutes commute (as opposed to the previous 40-minute drive, on a good day) and was the **same rent** as her previous space!! You have permission to give God some praise right here!

On 7th January 2022, the first week in the New Year that the firm opened, and less than two months since opening in the new location, Mrs. B. received a call from a potential client, a married couple, who inquired whether she witnessed documents and if yes, would she be available to do so on 10th January 2022. Mrs. B. advised that she would be in her satellite office (she retained a serviced presence at her former location) on that day but because they advised that the matter was urgent, she agreed to meet them at her new premises at 9 am. During that meeting, she discovered that a parent of the wife had died. This led to them querying if she did probate work. She said that she did, discussed terms and they engaged her. Both parties then advised that they had properties that they needed to sell and asked if she did conveyance work. She confirmed this and they agreed that she would do the conveyancing work. Her willingness to shift her plans and accommodate clients

who were simply coming in to have documents witnessed (a GBP 25 service) yielded three substantial pieces of work (with the possibility of more)!

Mrs. B. then shared with me that in December 2021 she made an application for business tax exemption and that she received word about two weeks later that she was granted 100% tax relief! Well by this time, I was on my feet rejoicing. But that wasn't it! While researching the business tax exemption process, Mrs. B. came across a grant award of up to GBP 5000 available to small businesses moving to new premises. Not having heard of it before but believing that she might qualify, she applied online at 7:36 pm on 11TH January 2022. Can I tell you that at 11:50 am on 12th January 2022, she received a response, which soon after led to a full award of GBP 5000? The money hit her account on 28 January 2022!!

What an unexpected "now" blessing. Hal-le-lu-jah!!!



THE REVEALED WORD

So, while I generally believed the meaning of the song to be that everything that has been stolen, everything that is owed, every promise, every gift that we are claiming and that's available to us, the Lord wants us to know that they are coming to us. Now, during the week of 10th January 2022, the Holy Spirit revealed that there was so much more!

He took me to the book of Genesis 37:24- 25 initially (and later had me read chapters 28-49) and Ezekiel 12:27-28.

Summary

In the book of Genesis 37:24-25, Jacob vowed to mourn the death of his son Joseph until he himself went into the grave. He refused to be consoled and **indeed for 22 years he lived in mourning and let his flame go cold**. This is Jacob, the man who had significant encounters with God, Jacob whom God protected and promised the land on which he was lying and promised to be with him and keep watch over him wherever he would go... (Gen 28:12-22); Jacob who wrestled with God and prevailed thereafter being renamed Israel - meaning Contender with God (Gen 32:25-30). This Jacob literally forgot EVERYTHING of importance when HE concluded that his son had died. Two decades thereafter, famine had stricken the land and impacted his household so severely that he had to send his sons to Egypt for provision. It appeared that a man who had let his light go dim was destined along with his family to die from starvation.

I want to let you know, however, that Jacob received his unexpected. Jacob experienced his unexpected exceedingly and abundantly. Jacob was restored. In particular:

1. His spirit was revived (after 22 years of mourning).
2. He was reunited with his son, Joseph.
3. His son, Joseph, was given charge of all of Egypt.
4. He and his family were placed in the best of the land in Egypt.
5. He gained possessions there and grew and multiplied exceedingly.

6. He came to Egypt at the age of 130 years and lived another 17 years with his sons and family.
7. Not only did he see his son, Joseph, but he saw Joseph's children.
8. And he died after blessing his twelve sons and was buried with his forefathers as requested.

In short, the MESSAGE IN THIS SONG is designed to:

1. Revive you- Gen 45:27 warmth and life were returned to Jacob and will be returned to you.
2. Remind you- Gen 45:28. God is greater. Declare "IT IS ENOUGH" to the devil and that "YOU Are ENOUGH" to God.
3. Reconnect you- Gen 46:2. Immediately following, Jacob being revived God spoke to Jacob/Israel in vision. You too can be reconnected to God.
4. Redeem you- Gen 48:16. God redeemed Jacob from every evil and He wants to do the same for you.
5. Reposition you- Gen 48:20. Just as Jacob and Joseph were chosen out of the perceived order of the "laws of the land" (Jacob was second born and received Esau's birthright and blessing) (Joseph was 11th born and became ruler) so will the Lord reposition you. Just as Joseph had a pit-to-palace experience, so will you.
6. Ridiculously bless you NOW; the things that God will do won't be deferred, but we are on our road to connecting with our Josephs (blessings) and then some, NOW! Ezek 12:25-28



THE MEAT OF THE REVELATION

Let's walk through in more depth the story of Jacob and the parts of the story that God highlighted to me and which may be relevant in your life today.

- 1. Jacob didn't just mourn but he allowed his inner light/spirit to die and couldn't hear from the Lord.** The scriptures are silent on the point, but the Holy Spirit impressed upon me that Jacob had put himself and God on mute. HE allowed death, disappointment, and despair to drown out the voice of God and essentially allowed his inner flame to go dormant. This seems crazy as Jacob had seen God do such miraculous things and was even renamed by Him. It appeared that Jacob had such a close relationship with God, or didn't he? At the very least, Jacob's declaration and resultant action show us how powerful our emotions are and the suggestions of the enemy that we have lost that which we treasure most. Even those who are in authority, those who have encounters with God, and those who have seen him face to face can be deceived and disconnect themselves from God.

I encourage you to review the scriptures below to see how Jacob walked with the Lord and was blessed by the Lord prior to this crisis in Genesis 37.

Jacob was:

- a. Blessed by His Father Isaac: Gen 27: 28-29; Gen 28:3-4**

²⁸ Therefore may God give you Of the dew of heaven, Of the fatness of the earth, And plenty of grain and wine. ²⁹ Let peoples serve you, And nations bow down to you. Be master over your brethren, And let your mother's sons bow down to you.

Cursed be everyone who curses you, And blessed be those who bless you!"

³ *“May God Almighty bless you, and make you fruitful and multiply you, That you may be an assembly of peoples; ⁴ And give you the blessing of Abraham, to you and your descendants with you, that you may inherit the land in^[d] which you are a stranger, which God gave to Abraham.”*

- b. Allowed to see a ladder to heaven in a dream and had a conversation with a man which he later knew to be God and had the blessing of his natural father confirmed by his heavenly father. Jacob also made a vow that the Lord shall be his God. Gen 28:12-21**

¹² *Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.*

¹³ *And behold, the LORD stood above it and said: “I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. ¹⁴ Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed. ¹⁵ Behold, I am with you and will keep^[d] you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you.”*

¹⁶ *Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, “Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it.” ¹⁷ And he was afraid and said, “How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven!”*

¹⁸ *Then Jacob rose early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put at his head, set it up as a pillar, and poured oil on top of it. ¹⁹ And he called the name of that place ^[d]Bethel; but the name of that city had been Luz previously. ²⁰ Then Jacob made a vow, saying, “If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and*

clothing to put on,²¹ so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God.

- c. Told to leave his father-in-law, Laban, when Laban was treating him less favourably and promised that God would be with him. Gen 31:3**

"²And Jacob saw the countenance of Laban, and indeed it was not favorable toward him as before.³ Then the LORD said to Jacob, "Return to the land of your fathers and to your family, and I will be with you."

- d. Met by God's angels when he was going to meet his brother Esau. AND reminded God of his promises to him. Gen 32:3, 9-12**

³ Then Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother in the land of Seir, the ^[b]country of Edom.

⁹ Then Jacob said, "O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, the LORD who said to me, 'Return to your country and to your family, and I will deal well with you': ¹⁰I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies and of all the truth which You have shown Your servant; for I crossed over this Jordan with my staff, and now I have become two companies. ¹¹ Deliver me, I pray, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau; for I fear him, lest he come and ^[d]attack me and the mother with the children. ¹² For You said, 'I will surely treat you well, and make your descendants as the sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered for multitude.' "

- e. Allowed to meet God face to face and live. He wrestled with God and hung on such that his name was changed to Israel meaning contender with God. Gen 32:24-30**

²⁴ Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the ^[a]breaking of day. ²⁵ Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He ^[h] touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him. ²⁶ And He said, "Let Me go, for the

day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"²⁷ So He said to him, "What is your name?" He said, "Jacob."²⁸ And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but ^[i]Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."²⁹ Then Jacob asked, saying, "Tell me Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why is it that you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there.³⁰ So Jacob called the name of the place ^[i]Peniel: "For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved."

f. Safely reconciled with Esau and erected an altar to God. Gen 33:18-20

¹⁸ Then Jacob came ^[e]safely to the city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padan Aram; and he pitched his tent before the city. ¹⁹ And he bought the parcel of ^[i]land, where he had pitched his tent, from the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for one hundred pieces of money. ²⁰ Then he erected an altar there and called it El^[g] Elohe Israel.

THIS Jacob who had so many phenomenal experiences with God, who called on God when he was afraid and reminded God of His word, at the sight of his son's bloodied coat, lost ALL sensibility and shut himself off.

Are YOU like Jacob? Have you let your light grow dim? Have you allowed external circumstances to impact your internal relationship with the one who has continually shown himself faithful in your life?

THIS SONG is sent to REMIND EVERYONE to do an inward look so that, if necessary, we can repent and thereafter focus our outward gaze on where God IS and where He desires to take us.

- 2. Jacob accepted external evidence without conducting a spiritual interrogation.** He, therefore, came to an incorrect and costly conclusion. The Bible doesn't record Jacob having any communication with God or asking his sons any questions. The Holy Spirit impressed upon me that Jacob never went

to God about the physical evidence he received. He, clearly overwhelmed at the thought of losing his favorite son, relied on his own reasoning and drew a finite conclusion about what he saw. Following his conclusion of death, he allowed his light to grow dim.

Gen 37: 31-35 says: ³¹*So they took Joseph's tunic, killed a kid of the goats, and dipped the tunic in the blood.* ³²*Then they sent the tunic of many colors, and they brought it to their father and said, "We have found this. Do you know whether it is your son's tunic or not?"*

³³*And he recognized it and said, "It is my son's tunic. A wild beast has devoured him. Without doubt Joseph is torn to pieces."* ³⁴*Then Jacob tore his clothes, put sackcloth on his waist, and mourned for his son many days.* ³⁵*And all his sons and all his daughters arose to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted, and he said, "For I shall go down into the grave to my son in mourning." Thus his father wept for him.*

What about the obvious questions and responses? Where was Joseph's shoes? Where were his other garments? Where exactly did you find him? Why didn't Jacob request more evidence before he actually concluded that Joseph was dead? Why didn't he ask for the remains of his body? But most importantly where is his questioning of God? Where is the fervent prayer? It baffles the mind that someone who had such encounters with God, who vowed that the Lord would be his God could, when it mattered most, leave Him completely out of his crisis. The suggestion is powerful and unchecked, like a locust, it will eat away at you. In the case of Jacob, it stole the good part of twenty-two years of his life!

THIS SONG is sent for us to REVIEW the decisions we have made without consulting God. Is our mourning in vain? Are we wasting years mourning something that is not dead or worse wasting the good years that we have been given? IF YES, IT'S TIME TO SHIFT.

As somewhat of a bonus, I felt the Holy Spirit impressing upon me that many times people place too much significance on the external (physical things we have) or the gifts/callings we may have. The result is when that thing

becomes bloodied, soiled, or simply disconnected from us or we walk in a new calling, we are deemed (or deem ourselves) dead, no longer useful, insignificant, or less worthy. Consider the following:

- a. Jacob looked at Joseph's coat and the goat's blood on it and ALL REASONING went out of his head. He sentenced Joseph and himself in some respects to death.
- b. What coat have you been wearing that has become bloodied, soiled or you're simply no longer wearing and you and/or those connected to now have deemed you dead? Are you walking in a new calling that few people understand? Are you now considered not as relevant as you used to be? Not as highly regarded? People just can't figure out why you're not wearing that beautiful coat (lawyer, doctor, CEO, Bishop, singer, actor) anymore.
- c. Have you judged someone differently (negatively) because they are no longer wearing a beautiful "coat"?
- d. God wants us to be aware that he is repositioning us for something greater than man can see. Joseph had to be repositioned to be the deliverer of his family.

Do you want to remain man's favourite or God's favoured? Sometimes your purpose will require you to take off "the coat".

3. **Jacob heard the words (of God) that Joseph told his brothers to give him-** "God has put me in charge of all of Egypt. Come down to me; do not delay." Gen 45:9. I believe that Jacob was reminded of the dream that Joseph told him in Gen 37:9-10 where he actively rebuked Joseph. He likely also remembered his own experiences with God and the scripture says, he was **revived**. He woke up. The word **reminded** Him who He was and that his petulant response to a lie of the enemy had gone on long enough.

Gen 45:27- 28 says: ²⁷ *But when they told him all the words which Joseph had said to them, and when he saw the carts which Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of Jacob their father revived.* ²⁸ *Then Israel said, "It is enough. Joseph my son is still alive. I will go and see him before I die."*

Jacob declared, **“It is enough”**.

THIS SONG is sent to REVIVE EVERYONE and to empower you to tell the devil, **“IT IS ENOUGH”** and say to God, **YES, YOU ARE ENOUGH!**

4. Jacob **started to move** in response to the word (toward his blessing) and made sacrifices to the Lord. **He FINALLY called upon the Lord**. And the Lord spoke to him (Gen 46:1-4), told him not to be afraid to go after his blessing (Joseph). The Lord didn't stop there but declared other blessings. He said:
 - a. Don't be afraid to go to Egypt for I will make you a great nation.
 - b. I will be with you when you go.
 - c. I will SURELY bring you (and your people) up again.
 - d. Joseph will put his hands upon your eyes (i.e. he will be with you and close your eyes when you die).

When Jacob blessed Joseph, he opened with the following words:

Gen 48:15-16a *“God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, The God who has fed me all my life long to this day,¹⁶ The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil.”*

THIS SONG is meant to RECONNECT you to God, to REDEEM you from all evil, and to REMIND you of the awesome, great, loving, and powerful God you serve. He IS the promise-keeping God.

5. Jacob **having received all that he desired** and thought that he deserved said that he was ready to die after seeing Joseph. **But God had more in store for Jacob and He has much in store for us.**
 - a. He was sent by the Pharaoh to live in the best land (a land ruled by his son).
 - b. His possessions grew and he multiplied greatly.
 - c. He had no lack for the remaining five years of famine.
 - d. He lived to see and bless Joseph's sons.
 - e. He was able to bless and prophesy to all of his twelve sons before he died.

f. And his desire to be buried with his ancestors was granted, even our death requests will be fulfilled.

THIS SONG is meant to RESTORE and RIDICULOUSLY bless YOU.

Following the conclusion of the story of Jacob, the Lord took me to another book of the Bible and cemented His word.

6. The Lord highlighted his word in Ezekiel 12:27-28 **regarding the immediacy of the manifestation of this word.** While in prayer during the week of 10th January 2022, the Holy Spirit had me linger on that word. I believe that He was confirming to me that God controls the timing of the release of everything and that “now” means imminently. While the particular scripture in the context of that story spoke to the immediacy that the Lord would deal with those walking in rebellion, in this context He used it to show that likewise, He can expedite the blessings for His children.

Ezekiel 12:27-28 AMP says:

²⁷ “Son of man, behold, the house of Israel is saying, ‘The vision that Ezekiel sees is for many years from now, and he prophesies of the times that are far off.’ ²⁸ Therefore say to them, ‘Thus says the Lord God, “None of My words will be delayed any longer. Whatever word I speak will be fulfilled completely,”” says the Lord God.

As God started to reveal the full meaning of this song, every day of that week, He would cause me to see a rainbow. One day, I had three different sightings. I believe it was a sign to me (and to all that receive this word) that His word is a SURE word, He will fulfill His promises, He will bless the hearers and doers of His word, He will not delay but He will do it speedily -NOW!

THIS SONG is a declaration that YOUR UNEXPECTED (that which God desires to bless you with/by: the things that are unlikely to happen naturally) IS NOW.

May you be revived, reminded of God's promises and faithfulness to you, reconnected to the Father (if there has been any disconnection), restored, repositioned, and ridiculously blessed!



POSITIONED TO POSSESS THE PROMISE

While the song, *My Unexpected is Now*, is meant to be a catalyst in your life, we must not just be hearers of the word but doers also. Given the revelation from this story, we can be guided in our prayers to position ourselves to possess ALL that God has for us. Further, we can see that confession of the wrong words can cost us years—twenty-two years of unnecessary and unproductive mourning in Jacob’s case. This revelation was given to me in the year 2022 which I don’t believe is coincidental. I believe that God will make good on the word in this song, in this year 2022. So, to use Jacob’s words, I declare, “IT IS ENOUGH.” Lay hold of the message in this revelation, repent if necessary and reconnect with God, raise your expectations, and possess your unexpected!

Below are some declarations that I encourage you to make and some prayer points I encourage you to pray for yourself, your family, your nation, and the world.

Declarations:

1. My unexpected is NOW (of course you knew this had to be the first one).
2. I do not place undue significance on the physical and will always seek God concerning the spiritual meaning.
3. I am God’s favoured.
4. I am unlimited because I serve an unlimited God. I do not limit my thinking or allow others’ limited thinking to negatively affect me.
5. The Lord is my God and I trust Him completely.
6. I refuse to allow death, disappointment, or the devil to cause my light to go dim. I will always call on my God.
7. I shall not mourn anything past its season but I will trust God in everything so that I may always be aware of what He is doing for me.
8. I am positioned to possess EVERYTHING that God has for me.
9. Devil, IT IS ENOUGH. I bind you and your demons and render your devices inoperable and null and void in my life.
10. Jesus, YOU ARE ENOUGH. I believe you, love you, and am walking with you.

11. The blessing, the victory, the glory is on me. God said it; I believe, I'm open and I'm expecting.

Prayer Points

1. Lord, reveal to me any areas of MY life where I have allowed death, disappointment, and perceived defeat to mute my relationship with you and my relationship with others.
2. May those who have walked with God whose light has gone dim and whose lives have become dormant be revived and start to hear, believe, and act on God's word.
3. Cause me not to define my life or the lives of others by any "coat" but rather let me look to you Lord for my significance and be satisfied with MY God-ordained calling.
4. Increase my faith and the faith of all believers to lay hold of your word that You are God and that You are a rewarder of those who diligently seek You.
5. May my life always reflect that You Lord, are my God.
6. Thank You, Lord, for how you have moved in my life in the past, and thank You for your promise to release my unexpected to me NOW. You are not slack concerning your promises and You watch over your word to perform it. Therefore, like Elijah, I expect, will wait for and will look for the abundance of rain about to come into my life imminently.
7. Lord, if there is anything in my life that would block or hinder me from walking into the blessings that you have for me, please reveal it and give me the strength and the wisdom to renounce/remove it and walk free.
8. Lord, position me to successfully walk out my purpose and consistently remind and assure me that true success is fulfilling my God-given purpose.
9. Lord, I believe but help me in every area of my unbelief. Thank You for causing me to see the manifestation of Your word and giving me the platform to tell everyone of the marvelous things that You have done.
10. Lord, help me not to dwell on yesterday's encounter but to daily seek Your face and come into Your presence.
11. Lord, I am a sinner and I need a saviour. I believe that You, Jesus, are the only saviour. I believe that You died for my sins and rose again and I confess You as my Lord and repent of all my sins. Come into my heart and take over my life.

As I close, I thank God for entrusting me with this gift of song and with the revelation of His word. I also want to thank you for taking the time to read this message.
